## **Catering work:**

That you are behind the bar or serving a 3-course meal, it is important that you are presentable at all times. Being a good waiter/bartender starts by dressing appropriately.

- Plain <u>ironed</u> white shirt (for serving drinks and food) / plain <u>ironed</u> black shirt (if you are behind the bar) – must be **tucked in**
- Plain black trousers or jeans
- Appropriate black, dark grey or dark brown shoes trainers are a good option as you are on your feet a lot, but they need to be discreet and suitable for the event













The Dos & Don'ts

## Dos -

- Ladies: hair must be tidy and tied back
- **Gentlemen:** hair must be tidy and beard clean shaven
- Make-up must be natural and minimal
- Jewellery must be kept to a minimum

## Don'ts -

- Ripped jeans/trousers are a no go!
  - Tattoos must be covered and face piercings taken out
    - Body / smoke odours
      - Scruffy beard
      - Creased clothe
